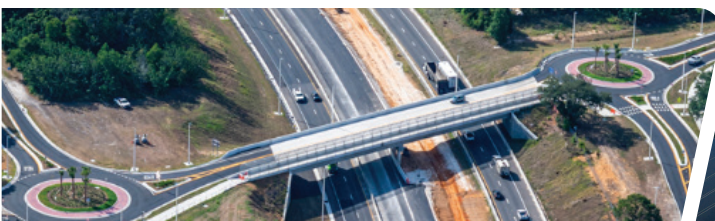

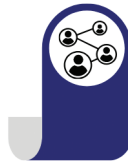

She serves on the boards of the International Bridge Tunnel and Turnpike Association (IBTTA) and is Chair of the Government Affairs Committee and a member of the Finance Committee. In addition, she serves on the boards for the Alliance for Toll Innovation (ATI), and the Transportation and Expressway Authority Membership of Florida (TEAMFL) and is a member of the Executive Management Committee of the Interagency Group.

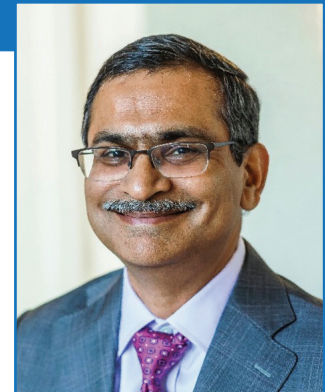
